

DEENE & DEENETHORPE PARISH COUNCIL

Minutes - Deene & Deenethorpe Parish Council Meeting Tuesday 9th June 2015 in Deene village hall at 7.30pm

410. Present: Annette Blackmore, Mark Coombs, Brian Gretton (Chairman) Graham Holding, Mark Martin plus the clerk. A PCSO was in attendance and 2 representatives of Illusive Festival and a member of the public with farming interest in the land where the festival is to take place.

411. Mark Coombs declared interests in both the Illusive Festival and Deenethorpe airfield.

412. Opportunity for input from Police – The PCSO who was present gave a short report into recent crime (there had been none) and an update on a family who had been living in Benefield parish for the past couple of months. There was a discussion regarding the changes to Neighbourhood Watch and speeding on the A43 and in the villages.

413. PRESENTATION by James Goldney and Lucy Hunt regarding Illusive Festival at Deene Park. There was a wide ranging discussion surrounding the arrangements for the music festival which would be taking place from 11th – 13th September. The main concerns from the council were over matters of noise and traffic – the measures in place to minimise the inconvenience of these were explained. The festival organisers are keen to engage with local businesses for hire of trailers and trade / food stands. The council will pass this to New Lodge Farms

415. Planning Matters:

- 15/00768/SCQ | Proposed LVIA viewpoints | Deenethorpe Airfield Deenethorpe – This was noted
- 15/00157/AFH Application under section 106BA of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 (as amended) for the **modification or discharge of affordable housing requirements required by planning obligation** relating to planning application 04/01326/OUT dated 3 February 2012 Open for Comment .Priors Hall Site Kirby Lane Deene – It was decided that the parish council would support East Northamptonshire Council in its approach regarding this matter.
- 15/00119/VAR | Variation of condition 4 to substitute approved Development Framework Plan (ref. BBD001/DFD/01 Rev C) with drawing ref. BBD036-005 Rev P pursuant to application 04/01326/OUT: 'Mixed use: Urban extension to Corby, including residential (up to 5,100 units), Employment (up to 14ha, 1 District Centre, 2 neighbourhood centres, Schools (1 Secondary, 3 Primary), Hotel, Formal and Informal Open Space, together with changes to the operating regime at Rockingham Motor Speedway, at Priors Hall Site, Kirkby Lane, Deene, Corby, Northamptonshire' dated 10.02.2012 | Priors Hall Site Kirby Lane Deene. This will be carried forward to a later meeting.
- 15/00976/OUT | Outline application for the development of an employment park comprising up to 121,703 sqm (gross) floorspace in use classes B2 (general industrial) and B8 (storage and distribution) (all matters reserved) | Car Park And Land Rockingham Motor Speedway Mitchell Road. It was agreed that the parish council is supportive of the proposal, but has concerns about the combined effects of various commercial and residential developments on traffic pressures on the A43 and increased volumes in the villages.
- Updated on JCS review and submission. Brian Gretton reported on a meeting he had attended concerning the North Northamptonshire Joint Planning Unit emerging Joint Core Strategy. Policy 14 remains in the strategy.

416. Update on Neighbourhood planning. This will be discussed in more detail at the July meeting. In the meantime, training briefings will be investigated.

417. Opportunity for initial discussion regarding village boundary. It was agreed that this is not something the council would like to pursue at the current time.

The clerk was instructed to invite Northamptonshire County Councillor Heather Smith to the July meeting to discuss matters pertaining to highways issues and noise as well as the Joint Core Strategy and Deenethorpe Airfield. The chairman would invite East Northamptonshire Councillor Roger Glitheroe for the same discussions. The matter of flooding near the brook was briefly discussed and will be agendaed if no progress is made.

There being no further business, the chairman declared the meeting closed at 9.40pm
