<p>421. Present: Stuart Barratt, Annette Blackmore, Mark Coombs, Brian Gretton (Chairman) Graham Holding, Mark Martin plus the clerk and East Northamptonshire Councillor Roger Glitheroe. Apologies received from Northamptonshire County Councillor Heather Smith who was unable to attend due to a car accident the previous evening.</p>													
<p>422. Annette Blackmore declared a pecuniary interest in item 427 planning matters. It was agreed that she would be able to remain in the meeting during discussion about this matter to answer questions only but would not be able to stay during the decision making process.</p>													
<p>423. There were no police present. It was agreed that if the meeting dates were to be altered later in the meeting, the police must be informed.</p>													
<p>424. Opportunity for discussion with county and district councillors regarding matters of concern – traffic speeds and volume, Joint planning unit core strategy. There was a short presentation covering Northamptonshire Council’s recycling record and the New Homes Bonus which facilitates a community grant funding pot to facilitate local communal projects. There was an in depth discussion around the safety and well-being impact of the A43 on the village of Deene and Deenethorpe.</p>
