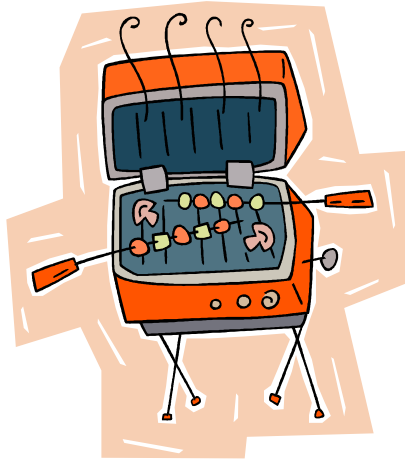


# Deene & Deenethorpe Newsletter
