Roads in Deenethorpe

One Way System in Deenethorpe

This has now been approved and we are waiting for Northants County Council to finalise the design of the signs. NCC also has to publish the plans so that people can object if they wish. When the consultation process has been carried out the Parish Council will be notified when the change to the road system is going to take place.

30 MPH speed limit in Deenethorpe

NCC has agreed to this and when they have a number of villages requiring a change of speed limits they will apply to Parliament for agreement. The positioning of the signs has been agreed.

For those of you who have chased the Parish Council about these items, they are still in hand

Deenethorpe Airfield Development

We are still waiting to see what the proposed development will be and are awaiting a consultation meeting between the Owner of the airfield and the local parish councils.

We understand that no application has been submitted to East Northants DC.

Another development that may affect us is 76 holiday lodges to be built by Forest Holidays in Fineshade Historic Wood.
